The Newport Symphony Orchestra Family Strings is a program to enable students to experience the fulfillment and joy of learning and playing a string instrument. Participants in the program will receive a series of cello lessons, an instrument for lessons and home practice, and a ticket for an NSO concert.

The NSO Family Strings program is supported generously by US Bank, Sponenburgh Memorial Trust, Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution Fund, First Presbyterian Church Newport, Mindy Simon and Adrienne Welsh.

Where: First Presbyterian Church, 227 NE 12th Street, Newport, OR or an agreed-upon location.

When: Twelve weeks, starting September 2018, for a thirty-minute lesson time to be arranged by instructor.

Costs:

- Instructional Fee: Families are asked to pay what they can afford (see attached form). Costs to NSO are \$20 per lesson.
- Music: not to exceed \$15.00
- Instrument: Rental: no charge with security deposit of \$100.00 to be returned at completion.

The NSO is delighted to provide the beginning string program for your child, starting Sept. ____, 2018 until the beginning of winter break, 2018. The program provides thirty-minute private lesson, once a week, with an NSO-approved stings instructor. Lessons will be held at First Presbyterian Church, 227 NE 12th Street Newport or an agreed place between parent and instructor. ***To participate in this program, students must be serious about practicing and following instructions. Also lesson attendance is mandatory and more than two absences will result in your child being dropped from the program (so others waiting to participate may be accommodated.)***

The program will provide an appropriately sized instrument for your child to take home and use for practice.

The family agrees to be responsible for the instrument listed above, maintaining the condition of the instrument and case in the same condition it was received. We also understand that any damage or loss caused by misuse, abuse, or negligence on the part of the student will be the responsibility of the student and / or parent / guardian.

There is a \$100.00 refundable security deposit for each instrument provided during the duration of this program. This deposit will be refunded upon return of the instrument within the condition referenced above.

Music Cost: Student must purchase music/CD required for lessons. Estimated cost not to exceed \$15.

Instruction Cost: The cost of instruction is \$20 per lesson. Families are asked to pay for what they can afford. Payment care requested to be paid at the beginning of each month for that month lessons.
