NSO Family Strings 2019

The Newport Symphony Orchestra Family Strings is a program to enable students to experience the fulfillment and joy of learning and playing a string instrument. Participants in the program will receive a series of violin, viola, or cello lessons, an instrument for lessons and home practice, and a ticket for an NSO concert.

The NSO Family Strings program is supported generously by US Bank, the Sponenburgh Memorial Trust, First Presbyterian Church Newport, Mindy Simon and Adrienne Welsh.

Where: Violin at First Presbyterian Church, 227 NE 12th Street, Newport, OR. Cello at church or Ms Welsh's studio in Newport (if needed).

When: Two sessions Fall and Spring, starting in September (specific date to be announced), on Wednesday afternoons between 2:15 and 7:15 pm. Weekly thirty minute individual lessons plus required bi-weekly group lessons. Longer lessons are available upon request and at the expense of the student (\$30 /45 minutes - \$40 /hour). Each session will include a public performance (December and April).

Costs:

- Instructional Fee: Families are asked to pay what they can afford (see attached form). Costs to NSO are \$20 per 30 minute lesson plus \$5 for 45 minute group lesson.
- Music: not to exceed \$20.00
- Instrument: Rental: no charge with security deposit of \$50.00 for violin or \$100 for cello; to be returned at completion.
